KINDERGARTEN

Please do not label any supplies except the book bag.

- 2 - 3-prong **plastic** folders
- 2 - boxes of crayons (24 count, preferably Crayola)
- 1 - box of markers (8 or 10 count)
- 1 - package of Play Doh (4 count)
- 8 - **large** glue sticks
- 2 - boxes of tissues
- 1 - pump bottle of waterless hand sanitizer (not soap)
- 1 - pump bottle of liquid soap
- 2 - containers of disinfecting wipes (ex. Lysol)
- 1 - baby wipes refill package
- Book bag (large enough to hold folders)
- Girls – 1 box of zippered quart plastic bags
- Boys – 1 box of zippered gallon plastic bags

FIRST GRADE

Backpack (no wheels)

- 1 - school box (cigar box size)
- 2 - dozen # 2 pencils
- 10 - glue sticks
- 3 - vinyl 3-prong pocket folders
- 2 - boxes of crayons (24 count)
- 3 - “black & white” composition notebooks
- 1 - pair child’s scissors
- 2 - boxes of tissues
- 1 - pack of baby wipes (for sanitizing desks-unscented)
- 2 - large pink erasers
- 2 - boxes of zippered sandwich bags
- 1 - bottle of hand sanitizer
- Boys – 1 box of zippered quart plastic bags
- Girls – 1 box of zippered gallon plastic bags

SECOND GRADE

No zipper binders or pencil boxes

- 1 - 2” 3-ring binder
 - 3 - composition books (wide-rule)
 - 2 - dozen #2 pencils (collected for classroom use)
 - 10 - glue sticks (collected for classroom use)
 - 2 - boxes of crayons (16 or 24 count)
 - 1 - pair of scissors
 - 1 - highlighter
 - 2 - VINYL folders with 3 prongs
 - 2 - large pink erasers
 - 1 - package of wide-rule notebook paper
 - 2 - boxes of tissues
 - 1 - bottle of hand sanitizer
 - Girls - 1 box of zippered sandwich plastic bags
 - Boys – 1 box of zippered gallon plastic bags

- 5 - glue sticks
- 1- 3-prong, 2-pocket folder (Music Class)
- Notebook Paper (Music Class)
- Boys – 1 box of zippered gallon plastic bags
- Girls – 1 box of zippered sandwich plastic bags

FOURTH GRADE

Please, no pencil boxes or zipper binders

- 1 – 1½” 3-ring binder
- 1 - 5 tab dividers (no pockets)
- 1 - 3-hole pencil pouch containing (every day):
 - 2 - #2 pencils
 - 1 - large eraser or extra pencil top erasers
 - 1 - glue stick
 - 1 - student scissors
 - 1 - small box of colored pencils
 - Loose leaf paper (check weekly)
- 2 - spiral notebooks
- 3 - “black & white” composition books
- 1 - box of zippered plastic sandwich bags
- 2 - boxes of tissues
- 1 - pack of sanitizing wipes
- 1 - large bottle of waterless hand sanitizer
- 1 - 3-prong, 2-pocket folder (Music Class)
- Notebook paper (Music Class)

FIFTH GRADE

Please, no zipper binders

- 1 - 2” 3-ring binder
- 1 - 6 tabbed dividers for 6 subjects
- 1 – 7½ “ 10” nylon pencil pouch containing:
 - 2 - #2 pencils (at all times)
 - 1 - pack of pencil top erasers
 - 1 - pair of scissors
 - 2 - glue sticks
 - 1 - dry erase marker (at all times)
- Loose leaf notebook paper (at all times)
- 1 - box of colored pencils (12 box)
- 11 - pocket folders with 3 prongs (variety of solid colors)
 - Ms. Stanek & Mrs. Watson only need 6 folders
- 1 - “black & white” composition book
- 2 - boxes of tissues
- 1 - bottle of waterless hand sanitizer
- 1 - bottle of liquid hand soap (Room 37 & 38 only)
